

Aim of the game

Team me up will familiarize you with the city in a new and fun way. Roam through the city with your smartphone or tablet and gather as many points as possible by answering the questions and carrying out some challenging missions.

Starting the game

The teams gather in the gaming area and log in using their game number. They take a photo of the team and come up with a name. Once all the teams have done this, the game supervisor gives the go-ahead for the game to start.




The movements of each team are represented by a coloured icon on the map. Your own team's icon is displayed larger than that of the other teams.

- next location
- your icon
- the other teams

On the map there is 1 flag, which is the next location you have to go to. There your next question or task will appear automatically. These questions and tasks have been determined beforehand by the game supervisor.

Questions

When a team is given a question, they can choose from several possible answers. On the next screen, the team will see if the answer is right or wrong. You have two opportunities to give the correct answer, but you'll earn fewer points for the second attempt.

After the question, the team's total score is immediately updated. Then the next location is displayed on the map, marked with a flag.

Tasks

There are several ways in which you can carry out the tasks: you can take a picture, or you can record some text or a song, take a video, or create a composition photo in augmented reality.

The result of your task is immediately forwarded to the game supervisor, who will allocate the points. The scores are immediately updated on each device.

Types of tasks



Bonus missions

The bonus missions are tasks that are not connected to a location. You can carry them out throughout the entire duration of the game. For example: take a picture of your team near a live horse. You can only perform the bonus mission if the moment arises.





So you're completely free to carry out the bonus missions where and when you want. The bonus missions will earn you more points than the tasks that are linked to a location.

Pelting each other

If a team is in the vicinity of another team, then the phone will alarm you by vibrating. You can start pelting!




Choose 1 of the three projectiles

Choose 1 of the three projectiles – a beer, a cake or a sock – and pelt the nearest team. That team will lose points, but they must wait five minutes before they can pelt you back.

You cannot pelt a team while they are carrying out a task or are answering a question or if they are more than 30 metres away. Also, you cannot start pelting during the first ten minutes of the game. This is to prevent the start of the game from descending into a chaotic throwing match.

The ranking

In the ranking screen you can see how well your team has scored in comparison with the other teams, despite the fact that you cannot see the other people's scores, only those of your own team.



You are fourth with 150 points

End of the game

The duration of the game is decided on beforehand by the game supervisor. This is usually 2 to 3 hours. If the game has timed-out, then all the teams will see the end screen. The players can then take a look at the photos that the other teams have forwarded. From the end screen you can return to the map to find your way to the agreed location.

Naturally a team may already have completed the specified route before the elapsed time. Until the time for the game runs out, the players have the option to carry out bonus missions to increase their score.

Keep it safe

Don't get too carried away by the game, but always watch out for traffic and other hazards.

Respect the traffic rules and beware of your own safety and that of others!
